Where and When?

The film society screens a fixed programme of films for its members and for visitors on the last Friday of every month (July and December excluded).

The venue for this fixed programme is the Hallhill Healthy Living Centre, Dunbar.

Screenings are at 8 pm, but you can arrive earlier to enjoy a drink from the bar from 7.30 pm (alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks may be taken in to the screening).

Additional community events for children and families, in other Dunbar venues, will be advertised separately - look out for our posters!

How?

Membership can be purchased at any screening.

Individual membership only:

£22 (12 months) or £11 (6 months)

Shared membership only:

£25 (12 months)

(Shared membership entitles one person entry per screening)

Entry on the door for visitors is **£6 per person**. If you enjoy the experience you can obtain membership on the night by paying the balance of the membership fee.

Members are able to attend the AGM, join the committee and generally get involved with the activities of the society.

Children/family events are charged on a per film basis for members and non-members at the rates advertised.

Narrowly avoiding jail, new dad Robbie vows to change. A visit to a whisky distillery inspires him and his friends to seek a way out of their hopeless lives.

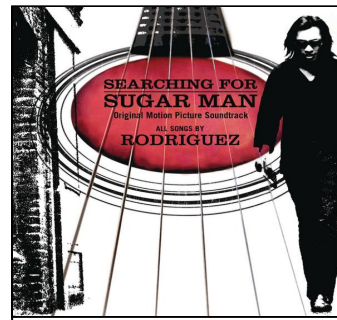

A young queen, married to an insane king, falls secretly in love with her physician - igniting a revolution that changes a nation forever.

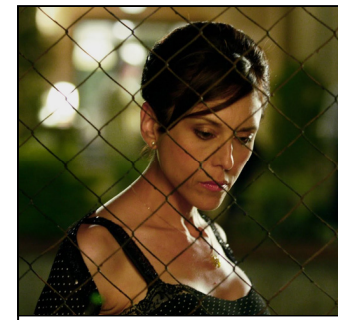
