The film society screens a fixed programme of films for its members and for visitors on the last Friday of the month (July and December excluded).

The venue is Hallhill Healthy Living Centre, Dunbar.

Screenings are at 8 pm, but you can arrive earlier to enjoy a drink from the bar from 7.30 pm (alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks may be taken in to the screening).

How?

Membership can be purchased at any screening.

Individual membership:

£30 (12 months) or £15 (6 months)

Shared membership:

£35 (12 months)

(Shared membership entitles one person entry per screening)

Entry on the door for visitors is **£7 per person**.

If you enjoy the experience you can obtain film society membership on the night by paying the balance of the membership fee.

Members are able to attend the AGM, join the committee and generally get involved with the activities of the film society.

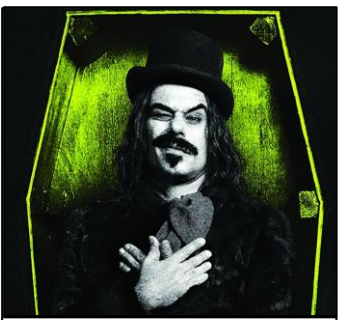
