Dear Friend,

You are invited to the Friends of Winterfield AGM on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> of May. We hope that you can join us and have your say on how we can best manage Dunbar Public Park and Winterfield Park. Please encourage your neighbours to come too.

Our parks are looking spring-like, finally. The wild flower beds are awaiting some wetter weather before seeding for this year's entry for Scotland in Bloom. I would like to thank East Lothian Council for their support with the maintenance and landscaping. Our ELC Landscape Manager, Stuart Pryde retires this month and I would particularly like to thank him for his instrumental role in forming Friends of Winterfield and support over the years.

East Lothian Council's proposal to re-run last year's public consultation will be discussed at the AGM. I am to meet, this coming Tuesday (7<sup>th</sup> May), with Bruce Allison of the Council's Landscapes Department; our local landscapes manager, Gordon Whitelaw; and representatives from the Park Rangers Service, Leisure and Recreation Department; Dunbar Community Council and ELDAP to discuss what are being proposed. I can update you at the AGM.

We will, again, host a Fun Dog Show at the park as part of the Dunbar Civic Week. The show will take place on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> of June at 2pm to 4pm. Please tell dog owning friends to come and enjoy an afternoon in the park. Entries will cost £1 and there are fun classes and free dog poo bags for all entrants. At 10am on that day we will also be running a park tidying session. Please feel free to come to this and donate an hour of your time to making park beautiful. Gloves will be provided.

Last year, we sadly lost a large number of Friends when the new Data Protection Act came into force and we were compelled to delete our electronic membership list and paper records. Prior to this, we wrote to all Friends and asked them to return a signed form giving permission for us to hold name, address and email address details. About two thirds of those I wrote to re-joined. I'm also hoping that our dog show will provide an opportunity to gain new members.
