You could be eligible for grant and/or loan funding, Try the funding finder from Home Energy Scotland

- Upgrading old inefficient storage heaters up to £400
- Photovoltaic panels (solar electricity)
- Solar thermal panels (solar hot water)
- Ground and air source heat pumps
- EV Charging Point renewables grants are from £150 up to £850

- Do-it-yourself loft insulation, if the insulating companies won't do it
- Insulating under floors or internal and external walls up to £500
- Draught proofing your windows and doors up to £200
- Upgrading old inefficient storage heaters up to £400

The eligibility criteria can be tricky to navigate as there are multiple pathways. See the Home Energy Scotland funding finder, or East Lothian Council can assess if you are eligible. If you want more details email insulateinnerwick@gmail.com and we will pass details on.

- If you are an owner-occupier your home must have an EPC band D-G. If your home is private rented it must have an EPC band E-G.
 - Means tested: if your household has low income (under £31,000), and you receive qualifying benefits, you are likely to get it.
 - NHS referral: if you have been diagnosed with a long-term condition impacted by a cold home you may be eligible.
- Under the Energy Company Obligation (ECO), the biggest energy suppliers have to help people improve the energy efficiency of their homes. There are different pathways to this funding.

Home Energy Scotland Grant

The Home Energy Scotland Grant gives you money towards a variety of energy efficiency improvements. The most you can receive is £7,500, or £9,000 if you're in a remote, rural or island area of Scotland. An optional Home Energy Scotland Loan is also offered to top up the amount of grant funding you can get.

- Insulation upgrades
- External wall insulation grants
- Cavity wall insulation grants
- Flat roof or room-in-roof insulation grants
- Loft insulation grants
- Under floor insulation grants.
- Homeowners can get up to 75% of the cost of insulation paid for by the grant.

- Air source heat pump grants

- Water source heat pump grants

Great British Insulation Scheme

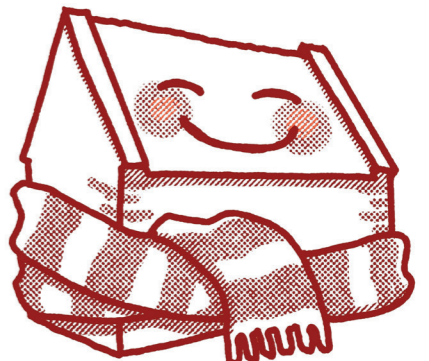
The Great British Insulation Scheme is a UK Government initiative, delivered through Ofgem. It mainly offers single insulation measures. The Great British Insulation Scheme is open to vulnerable people and those on low incomes. In Scotland, it's also available if your home has an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) rating of D-G, and your Council Tax band is A-E.

- Cavity wall insulation
- Solid wall insulation (internal or external)
- Loft insulation
- Flat or pitched roof insulation
- Underfloor insulation
- Solid floor insulation
- Park home insulation
- Room-in-roof insulation

- Solar Panels
- Air Source Heat Pumps
- Electric Storage Heaters
- First Time Central Heating
- Boilers (Non-condensing gas boiler to condensing boiler upgrade, like for like swaps)

- Cavity wall insulation (in certain circumstances)
- Loft insulation
- Internal Wall Insulation (solid wall insulation)
- Room in Roof Insulation
