Anti-social Behaviour.

Kenny Black, Antisocial Behaviour Coordinator with East Lothian Council then gave members a brief outline of his work. There were basically two types of problems – one mainly concerned complaints about property, individuals etc and the second one

was of more neighbourhood problems, ie. gangs of young people. The community liaison team are often sent in to deal with the latter. The Coordinator oversees these

matters. There is a shift towards concern for victims and the causes of anti social behaviour and

also to have a more visible presence (community wardens) if possible.

Any problems of antisocial behaviour should be reported to either the local elected

representative or to K. Black at the Council.

Mr Black was thanked for his input.
